SALMONIDS IN THE CLASSROOM: SALMON DISSECTION

This activity is designed for teachers and students participating in the Salmonids in the Classroom program of Fisheries and Oceans Canada. Whole frozen salmon may be obtained, if available, from local **Community Advisors of DFO**. - golf ball (represents human eye)
- probe
- latex or plastic gloves
- paper plates
- cleaning supplies
- garbage bags for waste
- ice-cream buckets
